Railway Estate State School will receive**

\$103,103*

This funding will be used to

- Increase mean scale score in Years 3 and 5 NAPLAN writing equal to or above Similar Queensland State Schools (SQSS).
- Increase the percentage of students achieving results in the upper two bands in NAPLAN reading and writing equal to/above SQSS.
- Reduce the percentage of students attending <85% from 25% to 10% or less.
- Maintain 85% of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English.

Our initiatives include

- Develop teacher capability in implementing quality teaching and learning strategies within the school pedagogical framework, leading students to successful independent application of learning.
- Develop teacher clarity of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptions, achievement standards and general capabilities by designing and supporting rigorous alignment processes for unit planning, teaching, assessment and reporting.
- Develop teacher capability to use evidence driven instruction to analyse specific evidence of learning and to plan relevant instruction for student assessment tasks.
- Develop teacher capability to monitor learning, to ensure that all students are progressing towards successful completion of assessment tasks
- Develop and implement an attendance case management system.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Procuring 0.6FTE Head of Pedagogy to lead teacher capability in high yield teaching practices: **\$74,058****
- Providing release time for teachers to engage in collaborative planning and inquiry: **\$29,445****
